Additional Master's Thesis Formatting Guidelines for Corcoran School of the Arts and Design Programs

Front Pages (Title Page through Preface, if used):

 The front pages of Master's theses must conform to the standard University Formatting Guidelines.

Page Size:

Each page should be 8.5 x 11 inches

• Page sizes ranging from 8.5 x 11 inches to 11 x 17 inches are allowed for images, drawings, etc. if they are placed at the end of the document.

Page margins:

• Portrait pages: Left and right margins: 1.25 inches

Top and bottom margins: 1 inch

• Landscape pages: Left and right margins: 1 inch

Top and bottom margins: 1.25 inches

• Full-page images, drawings, etc.: page margin requirements are suspended for these items if they are placed at the end of the document.

IMPORTANT: When requesting print copies through ProQuest, all full-page images, drawings, etc. will be reduced in size proportionately by machine to fit a standard 8.5 x 11-inch page with 1-inch margins.

Appendices:

- Exhibition brochures, when placed in an Appendix at the end of the document, do not need to have page numbers.
- *Images or Figures*, when placed in an Appendix with a short explanation at the beginning, do not need to be included in the List of Figures.
